

All-County and All State Awards Roll in for Pope

Pope Fastpitch tallied a program record 7 All-County players in 2011 along with placing a player on the Georgia Athletic Coaches Association All State team for only the 3rd time in school history.

The 7 All county award winners tie the 2009 team who also placed 7 Pope players on the All County team. This year's nominations were highlighted by Laura Beall who was named to the Marietta Daily Journal All Cobb county 1st team as well as the GACA All State 2nd team.

Beall had the best offensive history setting new school (.491), RBI's (44), Hits (52), % (.550), OPS (1.267), and only the 3rd Greyhound to be team and only the second player 1st or 2nd All County team's named 2nd team All Cobb

Rounding out the All-County Award winners for Pope were Rachel Dennis, Kendall Hahn, Ellie Viland, and Lindsey Walsh who were named to the Honorable Mention list.

From the honorable mention list, Lindsey Walsh set school records in 2011 for winning % posting a .769 win % with her 10-3-1 record and Kendall Hahn was named to the Georgia Dugout Club Senior All-State game that was played in Columbus Georgia in early November. The Georgia Dugout Club All-State team is for players in the senior class only and is a major accomplishment for senior players.

Ellie and Lindsey will both be juniors in 2012 and will be returning to Pope. Rachel Dennis will be graduating but is undecided about her playing future and Kendall Hahn has accepted a scholarship to play softball at Reinhardt College next season.
